We hope that you have had a nice summer holiday. Hereby a bit of news from the NORA team.

General adjustments of search functionality in all databases

In addition to a series of continuous adjustments that seek to improve the search function, new functionality has been added. Many users have requested the option to save a search. We have listened to this request and added a “save query” function in all four databases.

Furthermore, we are working on providing more options to export/download search results.

- In the database with data from Local Systems it will be possible to export records in full Excel-format, in several different reference-formats, and solely local record IDs.
- In the databases with data from Global Systems it will be possible to export the global suppliers’ record-IDs, which can then be used in the data supplier’s own system. We also hope to gain permission to export in one or multiple reference-formats.

New institutions in the database with data from Local Systems – and more to come

Since spring the Nora team has prepared for the inclusion of data from new institutions in the database with data from Local Systems. Until now we have solely displayed publication data from the universities, but before long you will be able to search publications from VIVE, The Ministry of Culture’s institutions, KDAK, and the Danish University Colleges – with more institutions on the way. We are currently testing data in collaboration with local key persons, and we look forward to giving Research Portal Denmark’s users access to publications – both research results and communication - from even more Danish institutions.

Initial meeting of the Advisory Board

On 23rd May the first meeting in the Advisory Board of Research Portal Denmark took place. At the meeting current efforts and plans for future efforts were presented and discussed along with a demo of the research portal. There was a lot of good input, questions, and feedback.
