Official launch of Research Portal Denmark on March 21, 2024

After a few years of developing and operating prototype databases, we are now ready for the Ministry of Higher Education and Science to officially inaugurate Research Portal Denmark and all its services. This is an important milestone, and we would like to invite you to a launch conference on **March 21, 2024**, in Frederiksberg at Ovnhallen, Porcelænshaven at CBS. More information about the conference will follow, **but please mark your calendars now**. We hope to see many of our stakeholders, current and future users, research analytics colleagues, partners, and others who are curious about both Research Portal Denmark and the research analytics field in a broader context.

February sneak release

For those who can't wait to try the latest services in Research Portal Denmark, we are preparing a *sneak* release in February for two new databases:

- A database with cross-searching across the current three commercial global data sources. Here, you don't need to choose which source to search in - the search can be conducted across all global sources.
- A database with cross-searching of data from local institutional data providers. The database
 provides access to searching in a merged version of local data without duplicates, providing a better
 overview and more precise searches.

In addition to improved search options, a range of new filter functionalities will also be added. In connection with the changes and improvements to the Research Portal's services, please be aware that some links to the current databases will change, and there may be a need to update bookmarks or saved searches.

Furthermore, we are well underway in giving the website a makeover so that it will appear more user-friendly and informative. We will send out **a newsletter** when we are ready with the February *sneak release* with more details.
