## February sneak release

As mentioned in our previous newsletter, we have prepared a sneak release of two new databases that you can start exploring:

**<u>Global Data:</u>** A database offering cross-searching across the current three commercial global data sources. Here, you do not need to choose which source to search in - the search can be conducted across all global sources.

**Local Data:** A database offering cross-searching of data from local institutional data providers. The database provides access to search in an integrated version of the local data without duplicates, which provides a better overview and more precise searches.

Please note that these are test versions that we will refine in the period leading up to the official launch. While there may be minor details that are not yet fully clear, we encourage you to explore the databases, try them out, and if you encounter any issues or errors, please let us know at nora.info@dtu.dk.
