



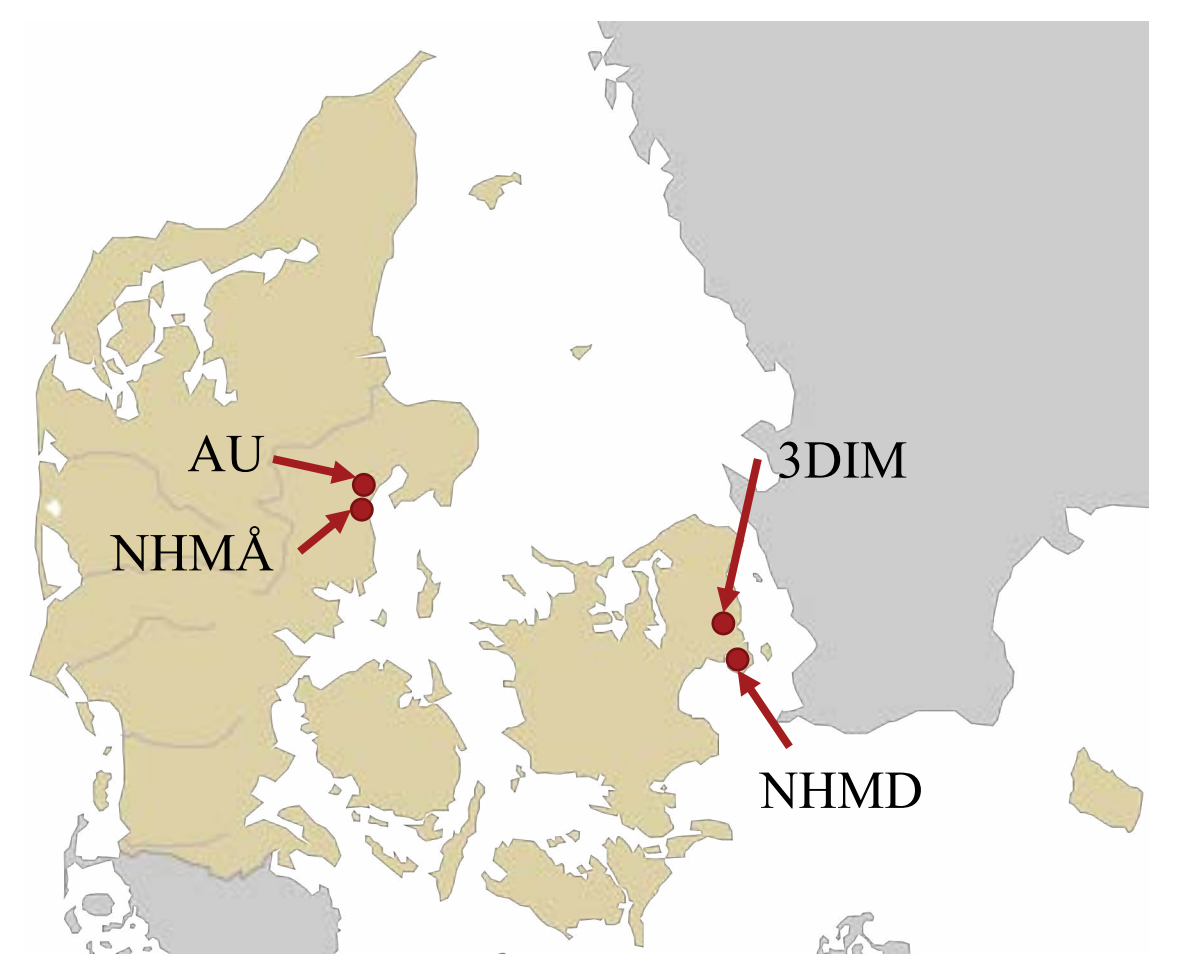
WHAT? DaSSCo is a national research infrastructure for digitization of Danish natural history collections. It is currently funded by UFM and consortium partners.

WHY? Natural history collections provide historical evidence of biodiversity allowing us to model and understand the impact of climate change and human activity.

- Provide innovative digitization lab facilities and workflows for mass digitization of natural history collections
- Provide innovative IT infrastructure for processing, storing and sharing digital extended specimen data
- To enable digitization of the 19 million specimens in Danish natural history collections
