As winter approaches, bringing shorter and darker days, we're back with exciting updates from the NORA team! We're thrilled to introduce the Research Portal's new [grants database](#), which consolidates a comprehensive overview of research grants from both public and private Danish research-funding bodies all within a single, openly accessible database.

The database currently includes awarded research projects from the Independent Research Fund Denmark, the Novo Nordisk Foundation, and the Carlsberg Foundation from 2016 onwards. In early 2025, the database will expand to include grant data from the Lundbeck Foundation, Innovation Fund Denmark, the VELUX FOUNDATION, and the Villum Foundation.
