Since 2016, the Open Access Indicator has monitored the implementation of [Denmark's National Strategy for Open Access](#). The annual monitoring is carried out by the NORA team, and we look forward to conducting the last official calculation under the current strategy in March. New Data Provider in the Research Portal

We are pleased to share that the portal's publication database, [Local Data](#), now includes publications from the National Research Centre for the Working Environment (NFA).

In addition to the inclusion of NFA publications, the database has received several new features:

- Two new filters have been implemented: 'Publisher' and 'Corresponding Author.' These filters make it easier for users to find relevant information among the vast amount of data displayed from Danish research institutions.
- The database now includes more publication types, such as 'Editorials' and commissioned work like 'Memorandum/Exposition.'
